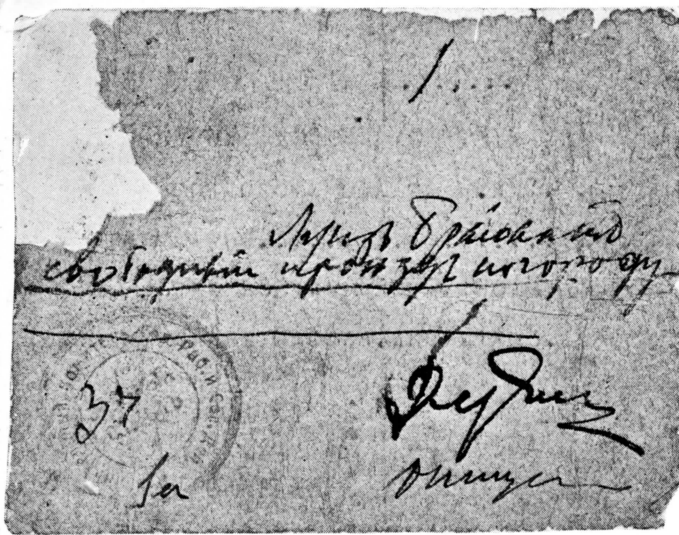

THIS PASS WAS ISSUED AT THE REQUEST OF TROTSKY SHORTLY AFTER HE BECAME MINISTER OF FOREIGN AFFAIRS.

CERTIFICATE.—This is given to a representative of the American social democracy, an internationalist and comrade—LOUISE BRYANT. The Military Revolutionary Committee of the Petrograd Council of Workers' and Soldiers' Deputies gives her the right of free travel through the entire Northern Front with the purpose of reporting to our American comrades, internationalists, about the events in Russia. Signed by the Secretary and Chairman.

THE REVERSE SIDE READS AS FOLLOWS :

This is a permit for free travel for the entire Russian Front and not only the Northern Front. Dated Oct. 16, 1917.



FIRST PASS ISSUED BY THE MILITARY REVOLUTIONARY COMMITTEE ON THE NIGHT THAT THE BOLSHEVIKI CAME INTO POWER IN RUSSIA.

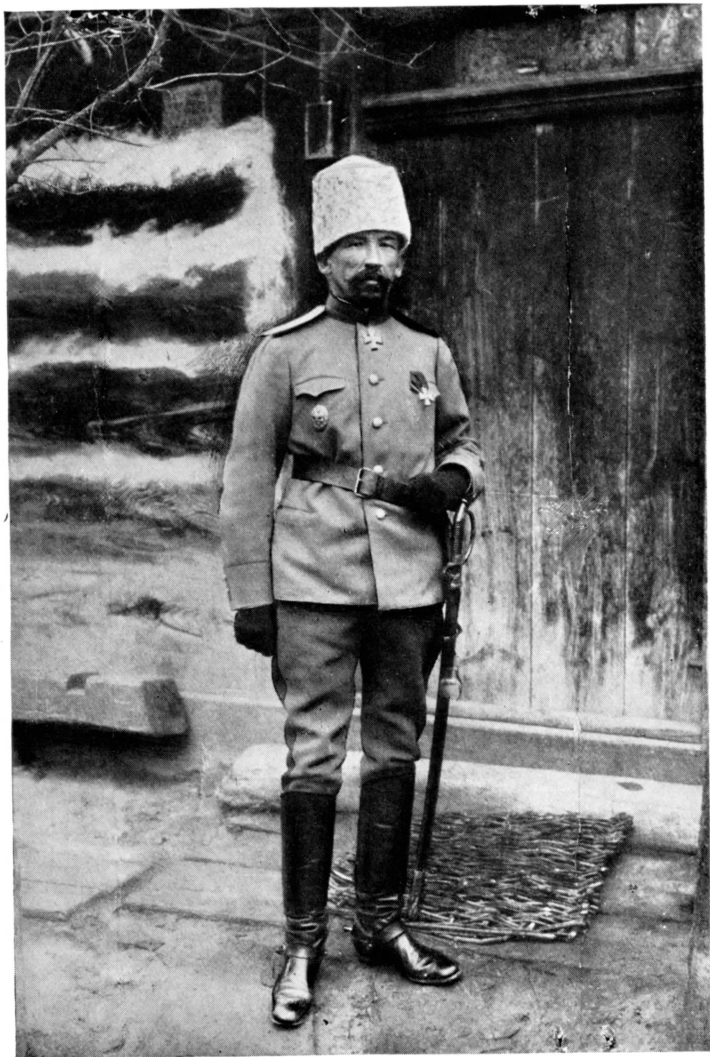

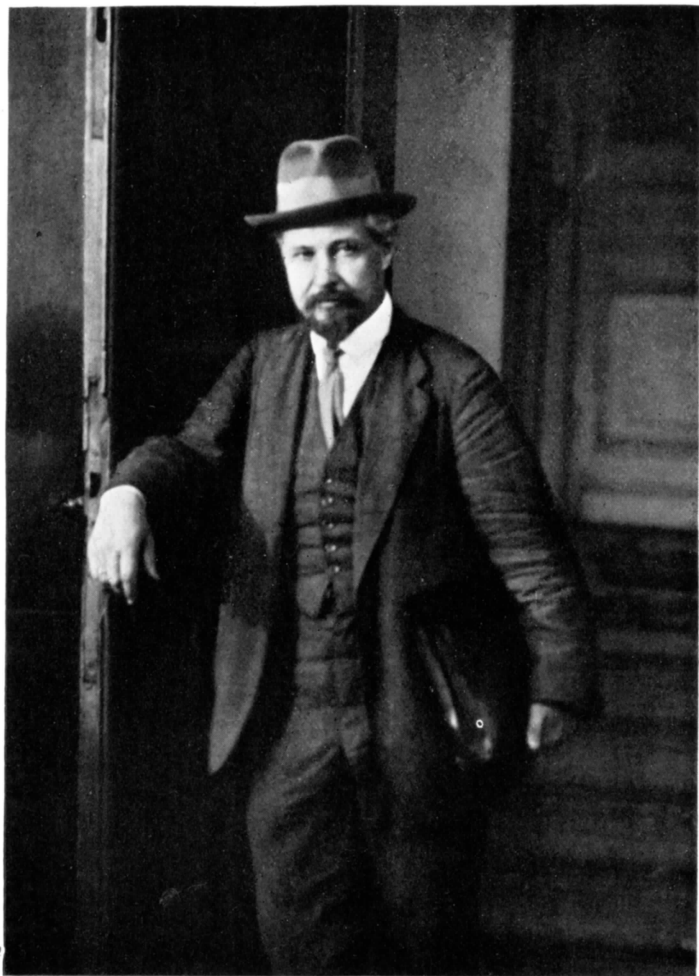

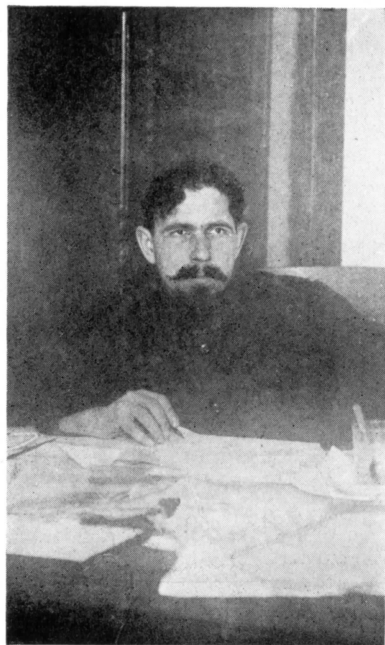

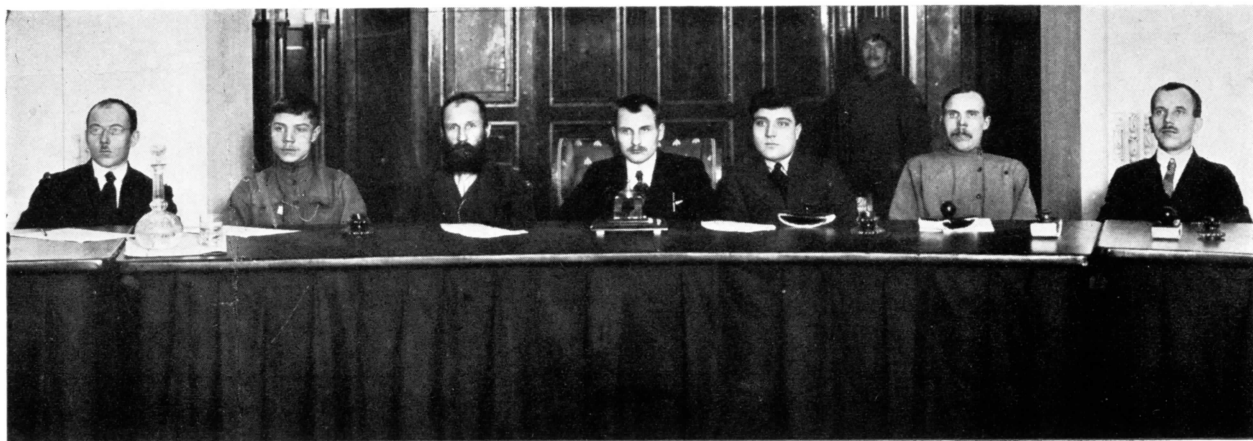
