p.641: "P'eng is one of China's ablest party military specialists. A soldier all his life & a combat Communist since 1928 when he led an uprising of Kuomintang troops, he is an intrepid warrior with an impressive career. A native of Mao's Esiang T'an country, he has loyally supported Mao in every test. In 1936 he emerged in 'hesi beside 'ao 'hou 'n-lai as leader of the armed survivors of the 'ong 'arch, after which he held top command posts throuout war 'rev."

"Early in war, P'eng replaced his subordinate, Lin Piao, as commander in chief of the Ch. Volunteers... He developed a kind of funnel warfare... (which) is now taught in China's army training schools. P'eng also became keenly aware of Ch's dependence on Soviet material & technical aid. From 1957 onwards he came to personify skepticism about 'too much politics in command'... P'eng neither led any 'conspiracy' against Mao against Mao, as reported abroad, nor was 'arrested'. The Ch party leadership does not work that way/P'eng still holds his seat in the Politburo.."
