General Baker, a Black auto worker and member of the Communist Labor Party, will speak on workers' struggle, the struggle against fascism and for busing.

Baker has recently been fired by the Ford Motor Co. for his union and political activities. Baker helped found the Dodge Revolutionary Union Movement (DRUM), which later led to the formation of the League of Revolutionary Black Workers.

His leading the struggle to build the Unemployment Committee at his UAW local, his political consciousness, and his fighting for workers' rights are reasons for his firing by the Ford Motor Co. on April 15, 1975.
