Gentlemen:

Yours is one of the libraries which ordered, and has received, a complete xerox file of the INDEPENDENT SOCIALIST MIMEOGRAPHIA. One of the recipient libraries checked the contents of our shipment and reported a number of missing pages. These "missing pages" fall into two categories:

- (1) Pages which seem to be "missing" as the result of mistakes in the page numbering, i.e. in the superimposed, handwritten pagination: Sec. C, pages 605-609.  
C, pages 1127-1134.  
E, pages 377-387.

These page numbers were accidentally skipped in superimposing the handwritten pagination. But we have confirmed after a careful check that *no pages are actually missing*. Enclosed are three sheets which may, if you wish, be inserted in the file at these points to call this to the attention of the user.

- (2) The other pages reported missing are individual pages, not groups of pages. We are, of course, supplying copies of these pages to the reporting library, without charge. You may want to check *your* file to make sure that these pages were supplied to you. Just in case you too find them missing, we are enclosing copies of these pages for you to use in correcting your file:
