FOR A STUDENT CONTROLLED APRIL ANTI-WAR STRIKE

Each year the ASUC Peace Committee goes through the birth pangs of conceiving an April Anti-War Strike. This year Dr Sproul has taken this trying event completely out of the student's hands by creating his 11 man Committee. Needless to say the Exec. Committee has confirmed this abridgement of student control and student expression.

NAZIS CALL OFF MEETING!

Last week, faced with the threatened picketing by members of the Socialist Workers Party, the Young People's Socialist League, and the militant workers of the waterfront unions, the German American Bund called off its scheduled meeting in San Francisco.

Earlier in the week the Socialist Workers Party and the YPSL called for a demonstration around Madison Square Garden in which over 50,000 Anti-Nazis participated. According to reports from the New York Times the SWP was the only left wing group that called for a picket line against the fascists!... In Los Angeles the YPSL and the SWP led the Anti-Nazis in action against the Bund. Here in San Francisco we see what local effect militant demonstrations can have...the Nazis called off a scheduled meeting!

This must be our answer to every move the Bund makes. We must smash the fascists before they gain serious influence. The labor unions must for their own protection prevent the growth of those who in Germany and Italy have completely destroyed the legally organized labor movement.

Here on the campus students have only to look at what has happened to the world renowned universities of Germany to recognize what a menace Fascism is to Academic Freedom.

Picket every Nazi-Bund meeting! Demonstrate your opposition to Fascism!

At its last meeting the ASUC Peace Committee called together all interested campus groups for a discussion on what should be done. The outcome was the organization of an All University Peace Committee and the issuance, by petition and resolution, of a protest to Ex. Committee requesting them to rescind their action. The Ex. Com. refused to do so. The score so far, then, is as follows: Sproul's 11 man Committee, an impotent ASUC Peace Committee, and an off-campus AUPC. Who will conduct the April Anti-War Strike?

There are two prerequisites for a militant April strike: complete student control, outside speakers, etc. and the presentation of a real anti-war program. To nullify the latter the Administration has always attempted to destroy the former. It has always recognized in the spontaneous and effective organization of anti-war demonstrations a menace to its own role as recruiting agents for the next war. It has viewed with apprehension the growing militant spirit in which the students have taken the war problem into their own hands. There is no other course for the Administration than to attempt to break the moral backbone of these demonstrations! There is no other course for us than to completely reject the 11 man committee!

Yesterday the ASUC Peace Committee announced that it will present a list of student speakers as requested by the Sproul "Peace Committee". It also refused to take any definite stand against the 11 man committee.

Having protested once they now
feel perfectly content to strag-
gle behind the Administration
picking up whatever crumbs are
condescendingly thrown to them.

Thus the All University
Peace Committee remains as the
only association of student
groups that might be able to
conduct the April strike. Will
it do so? Will it combine its
talents in putting over a real
anti-war strike that can teach
the students the necessity for
similar mass action as a method
in fighting war and give them a
program that will rally them
against the war-mongers?

The struggle against the al-
ready organized war forces,
from the most class conscious
of finance capital to the most
deluded liberal and political
groups, must be conducted on a
clear and concise ANTI-WAR pro-
gram. If the Peace Committee
is not to become just another
pep-rally it must present the
basis for a campaign that will
arouse mass sentiment and mass
movements to combat the pro-war
propoganda of the imperialists
and their agents.

The YPSL presents a program
for the April ANTI-WAR STRIKE:

1. For a Popular Referendum
on all wars. Opposition to the
"11-day" plans.
2. For a campaign against
the re-armament program.
3. Against Compulsory ROTC,
use of NYA for Pilot schools,
and militarization for the CCC.
4. For the support of labor
in its embargoes and boycotts
against fascist countries.
