In the beginning of May six comrades of the Partido Obrero Revolucionario de Espana, Spanish section of the Fourth International were arrested by the fascist police in Bajo Llobregat, a working class suburb of Barcelona. Karmele Guinea Anasagasti, Jordi Pares Queralt, Juan Jose Borrás, Josep Lluís Monar Thomas, Josep Maria Corbella Rosset, and Lluís Bengoa Maldonado. They are accused of belonging to the PORE, of distributing the literature of the Fourth International, the Revolutionary Youth International, and the literature of the PORE in Spain. More specifically, the communique issued by the Chief of Police of Bajo Llobregat shows the real reason for the arrest and why these militants were singled out -- they are accused of being the local leadership of the PORE and the Revolutionary Youth of Spain and in particular, of mobilizing the working class in Barcelona for the demonstrations on May 1st. These are not "arbitrary" arrests but arrests designed to crush the vanguard of the working class and its party in Spain -- the only basis for the accord for their alleged "democratic change" of the Juan Carlos regime.

On May 27th, two militants of the Trotskyist Organization, US Supporter of the Fourth International, Kevin Fitzpatrick and Barbara Putnam, were arrested at Ford River Rouge in Detroit by the Ford special police and the Dearborn police and charged with "trespassing." The trial will be held on Tuesday, June 15th. The real charge against them was stated by the Ford special police officer when he told our militants; "We've been waiting to get you for a long time." This is the real charge -- that the Trotskyist Organization and the Revolutionary Worker Youth have been fighting at River Rouge for many months, organizing the workers at River Rouge under the banner of the world party of the socialist revolution, mobilizing the workers in their confrontation with Ford Motor and the treacherous leaderships in the working

With each day the unification of the workers of the Americas with the workers of Europe in the world party to defend and prepare the workers revolution becomes increasingly possible, necessary and urgent!

All of the workers, and especially the young, sense that in response to the assaults of the working class which have brought down one government after another and one corrupt ruler after another, the imperialists, their politicians and their agents in the workers movement are organizing a vast plot to save their skins. But these same gentlemen are doing their best to hide the true nature of this plot from the working class and its vanguard, the only means to defeat them. This is the unification of the working class in the world party, the Fourth International, to expose and destroy all the treacherous leaderships, above all the Kremlin bureaucracy's international apparatus of Stalinist parties led by Brezhnev, which preaches peaceful coexistence with the imperialists in the name of communism; to destroy the capitalist state and establish a workers government in every country. In the United States the resolution of these tasks passes through the rebuilding of the US Section of the Fourth International.

Many think that the plot of imperialism, of the US ruling class, consists essentially in spying on people, in organizing clandestine operations through the FBI or the CIA to kill this or that popular leader or overthrow this or that government which it doesn't care for. In reality it consists above all in attempting to reinforce the illusions of the working class in the possibility of reforming the capitalist state, in Stalinism and in the leaderships which propose reform, like the Social Democrats in Europe or the trade union bureaucrats in the US, but above all the Stalinists, while attempting to crush the true party of the working class, the Fourth International, and preparing to crush the whole working class and all its organizations.

In the last days the international and true character of this plot has become increasingly apparent. The capitalists have published article after article praising Juan Carlos, King of Spain, and his wife Sofia, for their alleged effort to effect a peaceful transition from fascism to "democracy", and the agents of Brezhnev's Kremlin for their collaboration. "It's heartening that the King and Queen are taking steps to erase old wrongs, while setting the stage for anticipated democratic changes," says the DETROIT NEWS. "We want no Portugalization of Spain... we don't want a minority to radicalize the situation," says a Stalinist leader, approvingly quoted by the NEW YORK TIMES.

Yet, at the same time, they are financing the efforts of Spínola, the old dictator thrown out of Portugal, to raise an army in Europe, and arranging a \$1.2 billion gift to Juan Carlos for "defense purposes." And right now, according to the LONDON TIMES, arrests and tortures in

the Basque provinces are worse than they were in the days of Franco. In the last two weeks at least five more militants of the Fourth International were arrested and tortured. All this gets little publicity.

All the promises of reform on the part of Carter, Udall, and Co. and their lackeys in the trade unions -- Meany, Woodcock, Abel -- and the "lefts," the Unity Caucus in the UAW, Sadlowski in the USW, Miller in the UMW -- who are supported by the Kremlin bureaucracy and its agent the "Communist" Party USA -- serve the same purpose: to delude and confuse the working class and its militants while the capitalists continue to attack the rising movement of the working class, while they prepare to crush it; something which they cannot do today because the movement of the working class is too powerful. This is the role of reformism and Stalinism in the workers movement.

Comrades of the Revolutionary Worker Youth! Youth, workers! Militants of the workers movement! Militants who claim to stand with the Fourth International!

The Fourth International has been rebuilt in the last years and months in an implacable struggle against this plot. And it has been rebuilt through an implacable struggle against the denial of the fundamental opposition between the working class, its program and its party, and imperialism and its agents in the workers movement, above all Stalinism, against the middle class leaderships alien to the workers movement which try to peddle this confusionism, centrism, indeed liquidationism, in order to serve their masters and their plot.

This struggle is not over, for precisely in the face of this advance of the working class and its party, expressed in the increasing opposition of the working class and its party, expressed in the increasing opposition of the working class militants to their leaderships, these middle class leaderships -- with that of the Socialist Workers Party in the forefront -- have deepened their efforts to confuse the working class and liquidate its vanguard and in this way serve imperialism and Stalinism. Thus the struggle against centrism, against the leadership of the SWP, to win the working class militants of the SWP to the rebuilding of the US Section of the Fourth International and to destroy this organization is indispensable in the advance of the working class and its party today.

Over ten years ago this middle class leadership -- with Hansen, Dobbs and Kerry in the forefront, Camejo and Barnes coming up, and the old leader of the Fourth International, James P. Cannon, giving his tacit approval -- broke with the International Committee which was continuing the struggle of the Fourth International. They openly supported the international Stalinist apparatus against the working class in Cuba, tried to dissolve the Trotskyist organization in the US, which was then the SWP, into the Stalinist organizations, claimed no International uniting the workers throughout the world on one program under one world discipline was possible, and organized a federation with the other liquidators of the Fourth International which

they called the "United Secretariat." For over a decade they have entirely ignored the problems of the working class and the construction of its party, attempting to organize whatever workers who came across it together with the middle class and the Stalinist leaderships behind the liberal capitalists on a program of "democratic" rights.

Now, all of a sudden, they've begun to speak in the name of the Fourth International, of the danger of Stalinism, of the necessity to fight the layoffs and the cutbacks, even of the necessity for a workers government, the independent organization of the working class and a party of the working class here and there. And they've begun to send their best holiday speech-makers -- Camejo, Kerry -- to the industrial centers, where the working class and its party is strongest, and thus where the opposition from the working class militants of the SWP is greatest. In Europe, in Barcelona and Madrid in Spain, in the Americas, in Chicago, Detroit and Cleveland in the US. Youth, workers, militants of the workers movement! Working class militants of the SWP and YSA! All militants who claim to stand with the Fourth International!

Do not be fooled by this treacherous leadership! It's a maneuver to block the struggle of the Fourth International, above all that of the US Supporter, the Trotsky-

He denies the centralism of imperialism and Stalinism in the face of the assault of the working class, and the fundamental identity of the interests of the workers throughout the world against them, and thus the possibility, the necessity and the urgency of meeting the centralism of imperialism and Stalinism with that of the world working class and its party in every country.

All this, in the name of the Fourth International and the struggle against Stalinism, and not their plans precisely to subordinate the interests of the US working class to their collaboration with imperialism, their attempt to organize it behind the liberal capitalists and crush the proletarian wing of the Communist parties.
