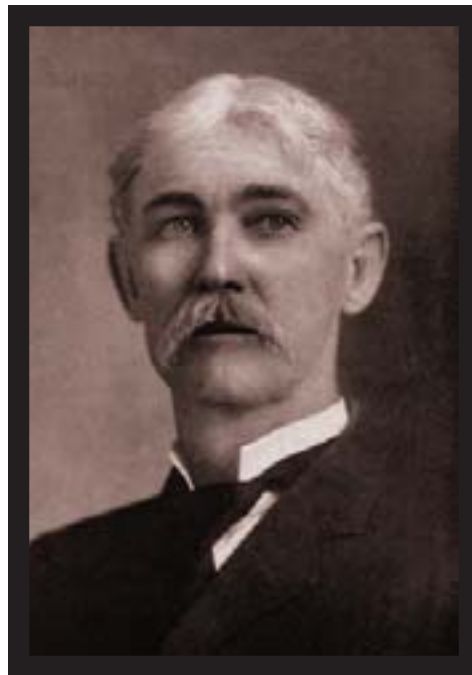

Telegram Read at the Funeral of Julius Augustus Wayland: Girard, Kansas — Nov. 13, 1912.
