A New Chinese Saviour

George Kirkpatrick, one of the socialist party's press agents, agrees with the capitalists that ignorance is the chief cause of China's troubles. But while the capitalists offer a solution for what ails China—long hours, short pay and police gas, Kirkpatrick offers Margaret Sanger and holds up a certain article made from rubber scraps for the evils that plague the Chinese masses. In simple terms, Kirkpatrick says that the trouble with China is too many Chinese. This is typical of the socialist way of looking at things. Instead of blaming the imperialist robbers for the dreadful poverty of the Chinese masses, they go around for some scintilla of evidence to prove that the Chinese are overpopulated. The only scintilla of evidence the Chinese to beget children is the reason why American, British, Japanese and British capitalists are now shooting them down on their own soil!

Kirkpatrick evidently read in the DAILY WORKER that the Wall Street government went to the expense of sending battleships to relieve the Chinese of their overpopulation. He then goes on to offer his own "solution" and makes the following suggestion: "The cost of one big battleship would be sufficient to provide every woman in China with one piece of privacy information—information used by the women of all nations, whether American, Japanese and cabinet secretaries in the United States—information on voluntary parenthood; that is a harmless, painless method for preventing conception; it is hygienic!"

The old Malthusian fallacy has been exploded time and time again. The earth is not overpopulated. "The cause of poverty is not too many people, but too much wealth. This condition will only be eliminated when capitalism is eliminated. There is enough wealth in China to take care of its teeming population for the next 100 years. It is the capitalist system of capitalism that then they can begin the task of disseminating capitalism, which will enable them to regulate their lives in accordance with their own interests and those of their neighbors. What the Chinese need now is more knowledge about contraception, a knowledge of how to use rides and a plentiful supply of water."

There are not too many Chinese in China; but there are too many imperialist thieves.

The Real General Fung

The outstanding military figure in the Chinese movement for the liberation is General Fung-Yu-Hsiang, also called the "Christian general." Fung was once a supporter of Britain and when Wu Pei-Fu was in power, he was a captain that ended in his eclipse. Fung was one of his leading generals.

In those days, the "Christian general" was pictured to the readers of the American and British capitalist papers in glowing colors. He was depicted as humane and democratic. But Fung was once the tool of British imperialism. He quit Wu Pei-Fu, lost his army and was the political end of Wu. Suddenly Fung went back into the picture as the British and American capitalist editors. His Christianity was abandoned of him like a coat of armor.

As the only coherent speech Fung went around hunting his old buddies, which he tried to do with a knowledge of his own capitalist traditions, was one clamoring for good and plenty of it. It was represented to be an bloodthirsty god of William Jennings Bryan. He had no program except an insatiable desire for an unlimited and unceasing slaughter. In view of this campaign of centralism, the DAILY WORKER is pleased to feature on another page an article called by General Fung to the Workers Weekly of Great Britain, the official organ of the Communist Party of that country. It is a long, windy, and somewhat hard to read, in a calm, reasoned document, setting forth the facts that led up to the outbreak in China, the bloody deeds of British imperialism and the determination of the Chinese people to free themselves from the blighting and brutal yoke of all foreign imperialist oppression. It gives us a clear picture of the real General Fung and not the caricature that the paid liars of capitalism dare to fool the masses.
