RED SCARE AND MURDER THREATS AGAINST BRITISH MINERS' HEAD ANSWERED BY CALL FOR DEFENSE

(Special to The Daily Worker) LONDON, Sept. 16.—A letter from the Communist Party executive to the labor leaders has been printed for a concerted press attack upon the labor movement in this country.

In form the press attack is against a "Communist conspiracy" to "run down" the army and navy. In reality it is a call for defense of the labor movement which is alert and virile enough to be prepared to defend itself against the planned and projected capitalist attacks.
