President Coolidge, speaking before the annual dinner of the New York state association of commerce, not merely reiterated his adherence to the world court of international justice, but he repeated and the se cisely what THE DAILY WORKER has contended from the first. He ed out that the rapid expansion of American financial inferests oad constitute "accumulating reasons for our adherence to the manent court of international justice."


