## Painless Agent Forced Out

For the second time within a month France is without a cabinet. The second Painleve cabinet has gone the way of the first. On October 28 the cabinet was forced out because of the failure of Calogaux, the finance minister, to stabilize the franc on the basis of American banking capital. The reorganized cabinet led Calogaux, the much touted finance wizard, out.

But the financial and economic situation in France could not be stabilized by the mere change of a cabinet. Technically the second Painleve cabinet met defeat on its financial program. Actually it was far more popular assistance than the mere reorganization of the task program.

In the final voting that resulted in the resignation of the cabinet, the vote of the 28 Communist deputies was the more important and American propaganda benefited before this fact. The chamber of deputies, after the vote that sent Painleve to the president with the resignation of the cabinet, voted to elect the Communist leader, Maurice Thorez, as the new premier. The Communist deputies were voted against the government. 4 Charges were made that the Communist voted with the right-wing against the government. The Communist vote which is the radical socialist under the leadership of ex-premier Herriot. The facts are they voted against the government, not against other groups.

Without the participation of the Communists the government had a majority. Realizing that their votes would block the government the Communist vote against the government. This offers an opportunity for the Communists to speak to the masses of France in their own words. The fact that they will go before the workers and expose the shameful role of the so-called socialists and the bourgeois parties of the left whose hands are stained with the blood of the workers. They will tell the workers they will tear the veil of lies and slimy hypocrisy from the murderous faces of the socialists who were responsible for the butchering of the workers people of France. They will tell the workers the role of the bourgeois hirelings masquerading as socialists who aided the Painleve government in jailing the Communist deputies of the Chamber of Deputies.
