Northome Men to Ballot Saturday

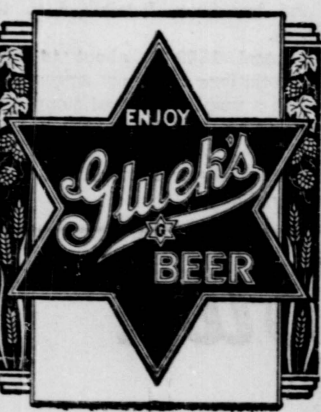

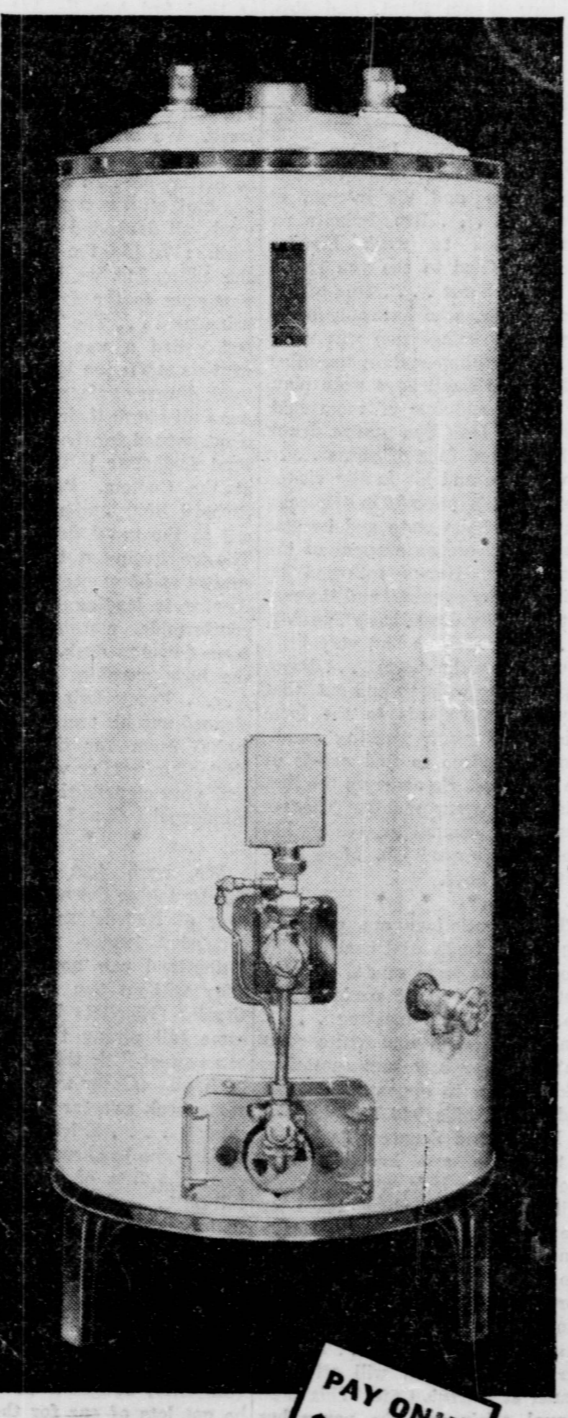
