In Europe there are 'syndicats' or unions of all shades of sconomic and political feeling: there are Catholic' syndicats' raternal "syndicats," socialist "syndicats," vegetarian "syndicats and "syndicats" of many other kinds, most of them organized on lines similar to the A. F. of L.

The seemad blunder was the indiscriminate classification of sabotage with "violence," 'terrorism," etc. If the men who drafted these "anti' bills would have taken the trouble to have informed themselves of the meaning of sabotage, as defined by those who advocate its use as, a tactic in the class war, a great deal of this incongruity would have been avoided. As they stand they merely demonstate the cobrious fact that these laws are not aimed at "crime" or "syndicalism," but at the I. W. Vic. It is noteworthy fact that the governor of the state of Washington has given evidence of good common sense by honoring this piece of legislative stupidity with his veto. What will happen in the other states remains to be seen.
