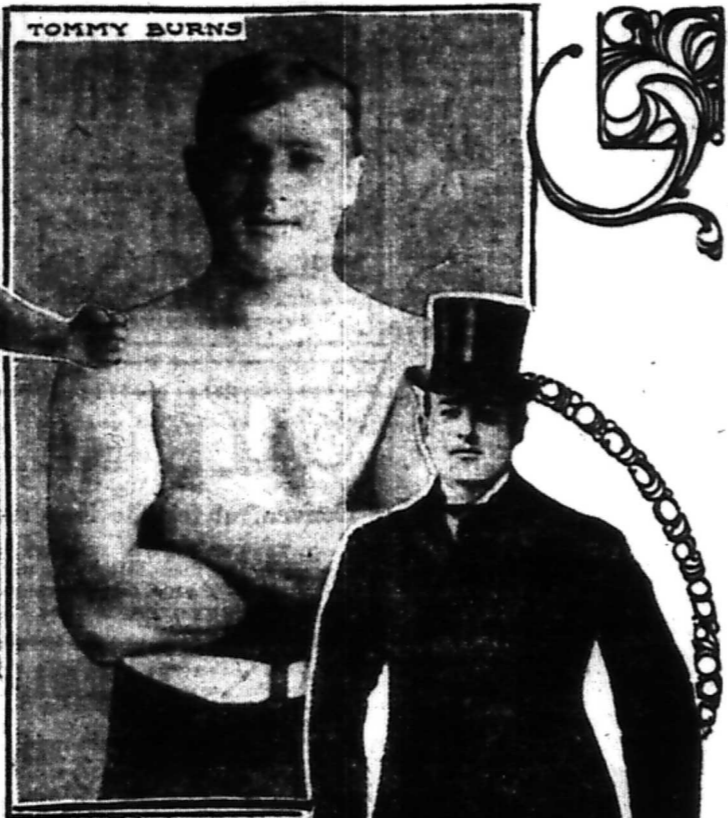
JOHNSON FAVORITE AMONG FIGHTERS

Many Brooklyn Workingmen Will Honor Socialist Veteran.

The funeral ceremony over the remains of Herman Gottschalk at 2 P. M. to-morrow in the Brooklyn Labor Lyceum, 349 Willoughby avenue, will be simple but impressive.

Mr. Gottschalk was almost sixty-nine years old at the time of his death. He had been active in the Socialist movement for many years, being considered a veteran already before most of the present adherents of the movement had entered its ranks.

The deceased was a member of the old Workingmen's International Association and was one of the founders of the "New Yorker Volkszeitung."
