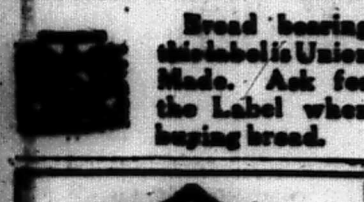

Aged East Side Hermit Dies as He Lived—Alone

Without Mourners, Body of Le Viness Will Be Carried to Lonely Grave, Following That of Wife.

Tomorrow morning, from an undertaker's establishment at 228 East 4th street, Joseph Le Viness, eighty-three years old, who died yesterday morning, will be carried in a cold-looking pine box to a cemetery up in Westchester county.

No mourners will attend the funeral, no carriages will follow the hearse, no flowers will decorate the coffin.

His wife died in the same house forty years ago, and since then he has rarely left the little hall bedroom on the third floor front, the room in which she breathed her last.

LUSTIG INDICTED FOR SLAYING WIFE

Walter Must Stand Trial on Charge of Administering Poison in Guise of Medicine.

An indictment was returned by the grand jury against Maurice M. Lustig yesterday, charging him with murder in the first degree. He is accused of causing the death of his wife, Rhode Irene Lustig, October 29, 1909, by administering to her five grains of strychnine in the guise of medicine to relieve an illness from which she was suffering.

Lustig was arrested a month ago. The police and the grand jury have been investigating the case ever since.

Lustig is a waiter. He also conducted a night watchman service in Harlem. He will be arraigned before Judge Rensselaer in the Court of General Sessions today for pleading.

HIGHWAYMAN GETS THIRD LONG TERM

Nineteen-year Sentences to Sing Sing Also Imposed Upon Three Other Brooklyn Bandits.

Charles Morton, an ex-convict, was sentenced to twenty years at hard labor in Sing Sing for highway robbery by Judge Dike in the Kings County Court, Brooklyn, yesterday.

Morton, whose home is at 510 East 18th street, Manhattan, had only been out of prison a few months, after serving a term for grand larceny, when, on January 12, he knocked down Louis Grollman, of 442 Wynn street, Brooklyn, and robbed him of \$70.

Nellie White, who helped Morton rob Grollman, has pleaded guilty to assault, and is in Raymond Street Jail awaiting sentence.

Judge Dike also inflicted heavy punishment upon three other men who came before him yesterday for robbery in the first degree.

DICKINSON DENIES AIDING PACIFIC MAIL CO.

WASHINGTON, Feb. 28.—Charges that under the management of Secretary Dickinson, of the War Department, there had been discrimination against American shippers in Panama railroad rates and that he had turned down an opportunity to break the monopoly of the Pacific Mail Steamship line were answered by the secretary before the senate committee on inter-oceanic canals today.

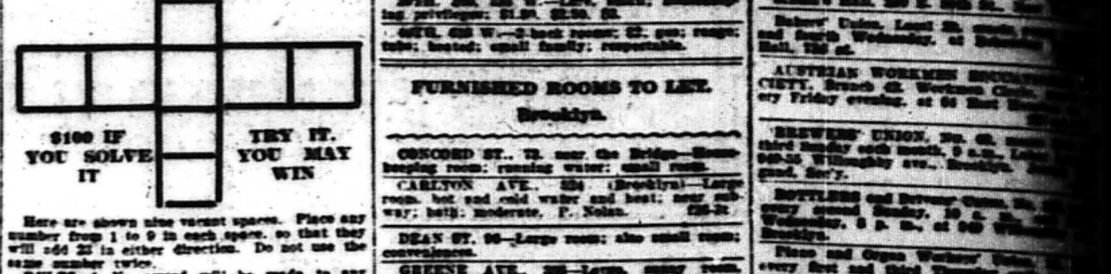
