"The Rev. William N. Ackley having been discharged by the vestry of this church, notice is hereby given to the congregation thereof that the doors of this church will be closed on Sunday, September 11, 1910, and until such time as the vestry can provide a pastor in the place of said Rev. William N. Ackley."

At the hour for Sunday school, 2:30 p.m., a number of the hostile vestry were present together with a big crowd of children and women. As Dr. Ackley, a slight little man with white hair and white, Dunderberg, approached the vestrymen moved across the street.
