When the Weekly Pledge Fund was inaugurated it was then estimated that unless The Call can be assured of a weekly sustaining fund of not less than \$600 the existence of the paper will be doubtful.

The weekly expense at present averages \$1,965.40, which is about \$375 less than the weekly expenditures were eight months ago.

The last two weeks have been, perhaps, the best in the history of the paper. The business report for the week ended November 26 shows a business income (not including donations of any sort) of \$2,030.08.
