WILKES-BARRE, Pa., Dec. 20.—Owing to lack of funds the State Health Department was obliged today to discontinue supplying fresh eggs to indigent tuberculosis patients and also to adopt other forms of retrenchment.

SOCIALISTS DEMAND THAT MAYOR ACT Bridgeport Local Shows Power of City to Compel Better Car Service.

BRIDGEPORT, Conn., Dec. 20.—The Socialist party of Bridgeport has entered the fight to compel the Connecticut company, which operates the street cars in this city, to remedy the present deplorable conditions of the trolley service.

The Socialist local believes that the mayor and common council have absolute right and authority by the city charter and ordinances to compel the company to give better service.

Be it resolved, That the Socialist party of Bridgeport hereby demand from the mayor and the common council of the city of Bridgeport to use the powers vested in them singly and jointly for the immediate relief and betterment of the street traffic situation in the city of Bridgeport.
